CALL MEETING TO ORDER

SWEARING IN OF NEW MEMBERS

Staff Burhans gave a brief overview of various resources handouts in the packets at the meeting(see attached).

Mr. Burhans explained the Granicus program to be able to listen to the audio of meetings that is posted on our website.

Member Alan Rosenberg asked about the list of approved trees in Indian Trail that are allowed to be used in new development; what we don't have is guidelines for certain types of trees for certain areas. He spoke about it coming to his attention in Phase 3 of the Bonterra area and the developer was going to put in large maturing trees where there wasn't enough room for growth to mature without affecting the curb and sidewalks. Member Rosenberg asked that Staff and Tree Board members create guidelines to give a developer for planning strips.

Director DeHart replied that Staff would research and bring back some proposal, go through an education process, then put together a zoning text amendment to recommend to the Planning Board, then to the Town Council.

Member Rosenberg stated responsibility for tax dollars where money would have to be spent to correct those issues as well as the potential for safety issues with roots that aren't sufficiently developed to support the tree, which would require the tree to be cut down.
