A. Safety Planning:

a) On-Street Parking:

Dave Drehs recapped the discussion from the previous meeting.

Art Spurr agreed and suggested No Outlet Signs on some neighborhood streets could help the situation.

Chip Long discussed the need for overflow parking for Kate Skate. He said it poses a real problem for safety.

Francis Knight was concerned with having a certain distance from corners for on-street parking. This creates visibility issues.

b) Pet Registration:

Sherry Waddell brought up the discussion of revisiting the Town's Animal Control Ordinance. She believes the Public Safety Advisory Committee should research and advocate for pet registration and/or pet licensing. This would make the people and the animals safer. The Committee discussed previous policy drafts that did have this as a regulation.

Dave Drehs supported the pet registration and licensing.

Chip Long discussed his past experience from Mecklenburg County, and agreed the Committee should continue to research the item.

Sherry Waddell talked about 'Pet Data'. It is a business that specializes in animal licensing. She suggested researching this company and finding out more information.

Francis Knight and Art Spurr both supported the idea.

Committee discussed related issues to licensing with the Dog Park.

Chip Long made a motion to support this idea. The motion passed unanimously.

c) Outreach Project:
