**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Indian Trail, North Carolina that:

The Union County Board of Commissioners and the Union County Board of Education should consider allowing Union County voters to decide the appropriate funding for school infrastructure and technology. This can be accomplished with a school bond referendum on the November 2014 election ballot that would address school capacity issues, and/or increase capacity at our current schools, and to renovate some of our older schools. This public participation would demonstrate a long-term and necessary solution.

Town leaders would also like to begin an open dialogue with schools leaders regarding other short-term options, including 1) Year round schools; 2) Extended day school; 3) Increasing capacity at current schools; and 4) Continuing an enrollment cap at some schools.
