






- Newspaper
- Glass containers

- Most electronics, such as computers and cell phones.
 - Tires and batteries
 - Chemicals and their containers
 - Styrofoam
- * Many of these items must be recycled through specialty programs to keep them out of landfills.

Recycling is vital to our future - just go ask the Recycling Club over at Indian Trail Elementary School.


"It's important to use the right bins because the trash goes to the landfill and the recycling gets turned into something new," said fifth-grader Madison






WHERE TO RECYCLE AT CROOKED CREEK PARK
