

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I reserve a field, court or park shelter?

Q: How do I find out if a field is closed or an activity has been cancelled due to weather?

A: The hotline for athletic field closures is 704-821-4950. This hotline will be updated in the event of inclement weather and the need to close down fields. We will update the line when necessary by 4 p.m. on weekdays and 9 a.m. on weekends.
