Truck Traffic Review

- NCTA provided Monroe Expressway Impacts on the U.S. 74 Corridor Memo (2019) that quantified the impacts of the Monroe Expressway on the U.S. 74 corridor, including truck traffic.
- Between 2018 and 2019, average weekday truck traffic along U.S. 74 decreased by approximately 200 to 800 vehicles, or 5 to 27 percent, with the greatest reductions occurring west of Monroe.
- Trucks making through-trips on U.S. 74 between Marshville and Stallings decreased from a weekday average of 23.8 percent of all truck trips on U.S. 74 in 2018 to 16.3 percent of all truck trips in 2019.



- Riverstone TIA recommended improvements at
 - N Rocky River Rd/W Unionville Indian Trail Rd
 - Poplin Rd/W Unionville Indian Trail Rd
- Poplin Rd/ Unionville Indian Trail Rd W on the 2019 UC CIA List
- Old Charlotte Hwy/Rogers Rd was on 2023 UC CIA Candidate Intersection List, but did not move forward because it has already been improved
- SPCC expanding; improvements will be required
- Long-term plan to widen US 74 to 6 lanes
- P7.0 projects
 - Rocky River Rd widening (holding tank)
 - Weddington Rd widening (holding tank)
 - Old Charlotte Hwy/Rocky River Rd grade separation (new submittal)
- Secret Short Cut Rd will be submitted as candidate project to 2055 MTP (previously submitted to 2045/2050 MTPs)

Town of Weddington

- No development activity near Town limits

- Agrees area between bypass and Rocky River Rd will be highest growth

- Recommended talking with Weddington about development activity at Town limits




Town Council

 - Too many high density subdivisions built and roads can't handle the huge volume of cars they have brought

- The roads aren't able to support the volume of traffic. We've outgrown our roads.



- It's what people complain the most about. It goes along with complaints on traffic. It's the social media nightmare.



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
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TIA Review



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


